

Dear Parishioners,

Greetings to all in this most unusual "Covid-19" time. I hope you are well and had a chance to relax and enjoy some of the summer days. It has now been six months since the initial shutdown. We have all been trying to find our way through these months meeting the challenges of everyday life. I thought it would be good to

send out a summary of where we are as a parish and to let you know what has transpired here at OLA.

OLA Census 2020

Since 2020 is a census year, the parish council initiated a parish census in January. We asked folks to fill out the census form here at church or online. Little did we know how helpful updated census data would be when we were shut-down these many months. We were able to create a phone tree to stay in touch with parishioners, especially the senior members of the congregation. Eucharistic Liturgy, Prayer & Worship

Our Liturgy Schedule: Saturdays at 4:30 p.m. we are streaming Mass. You can find it on **YouTube**, type in **Our Lady of the Assumption Faith Formation**. Once the Mass is streamed, you can access it at any time. Only the Lectors, Musician and Cantor are present in the church for this liturgy which allows us to have music and singing. Communion is distributed in the parking lot at 5:30 p.m. On Sundays, we have a 9:00 a.m. Mass that we are asking people to sign up for by calling the Faith Formation Office at 518-785-1605 or by sending an email to register, <u>ourlady@nycap.rr.com</u>. Attendees are asked to fill out a Covid-19 Declaration Sheet and are seated by our ushers. We can accommodate up to 90 parishioners at this time. We started with 50-60 parishioners but are now up to 80+ each week in the congregation.



Communion is also distributed in the Parking Lot on Sundays at 10:00 a.m. I am grateful to all who are assisting with this schedule. People are beginning to get the flow and all is going smoothly. I resumed Mass at the Provincial House on Sundays at 11:00 a.m. This Mass is restricted to the resident sisters at the Provincial House.

Tuesday 6:30 a.m. Mass is open seating, sign-in, sanitize, sit in the center aisle.

Wednesday weekday Mass is streamed at 9:00 a.m. with musician & cantor. We hope that in the near future this Mass can have in-person attendance.

Covid brought a strange end to Lent this year. Holy Week and Easter were all virtual on YouTube. I am so grateful that we previously installed the media equipment and cameras in the church and hall so that we could continue to provide Mass and spiritual offerings.
