

The second Sunday of Advent, Dec. 6<sup>th</sup> was also the **Feast of St. Nicholas**. The stately bishop, "Rick Doty", made his appearance outside as people came for Holy Communion in the parking lot. Gift bags containing chocolate coins, clementines, candy canes and coloring pages,

were prepared by the Faith Formation Team and handed out by Youth Elves.



**Frank Schaefer** was awarded the **2020 St. Nicholas Award**. This award is given in memory of Jim Sanford by his wife Kathy. Jim was our St. Nicholas for many years. The award recognizes a high school senior who is generous with the gift of time and often unseen for his many acts of kindness following the example of St. Nicholas.



Youth Ministry held their annual **Wreath Sale** on the St. Nicholas Weekend. The weather was a bit nasty but those elves were out there creating Christmas cheer.

The Angel Tree Program was a great success. We were not able to

accept wrapped packages this year, so we collected gift cards and donations to support our partnership with 10 agencies and shelters in the local area. What an amazing level of

participation. \$10,000 was donated to this project. Thanks to the members of the Parish Council Human Concerns Committee who organized this year's Angel Tree.
