### **Elementary Faith Formation (Grades 1-5)**

After speaking with many of our families, we have decided to offer in-person Elementary Faith Formation sessions this fall. The safety of our children and our catechists is top priority, so we will require masks for all children and adults who have not been vaccinated. We have not yet heard what the schools will be requiring of our children and we generally follow their lead. However, we have the unique situation of mixing many different schools and even children from outside our district. We feel it is best for all our elementary children to wear a mask until we can all be safely vaccinated. Even those who ARE vaccinated are encouraged to wear a mask. We will ask everyone to sanitize their hands as they enter the building. If you or your child do not feel well, please complete that week's lesson at home. We can email you the complete home study guide with all the directions you'll need. Your child can bring the completed activity pages the following session.

We will continue to use Saint Mary's Press, *Discover: Finding Faith in Life* for grades 1-5. This program uses as it's core text, *The Catholic Children's Bible*. Each child received their own Bible to keep and use in future years. Children new to our program will receive their own Bible this fall. Each child will receive a folder with grade appropriate activity booklets for each chapter.

We are planning to meet on Sunday mornings following the 9 a.m. mass. Our sessions will begin at 10:15 a.m. and end at 11 a.m. The Discover series has a wonderful Family Page on the back of each activity packet. This lets the parents see all the kids have just discussed with our Catechists, and continue the lesson all week. There are Saints and prayers on each packet to share with the whole family.

There will be several weeks that we do not gather together so that hospitality, or other church gatherings, can happen. On those weeks, we'll send a home study guide to parents so that you can do the assigned chapter with your child. The guides are step-by-step instructions on that topic. It's everything you'll need to complete that lesson with your child. (Even the page numbers are included!)

If you feel the best way for your child to participate in Faith Formation is to complete the chapters with you at home, and not in-person, we would be happy to make that happen. Please email me directly (<a href="mailto:kbpola@nycap.rr.com">kbpola@nycap.rr.com</a>) so that I can gather the home guides for you, or so that I can set up a digital platform for you. Although we'd love to see you here at OLA, we do understand that this may not be the best path for your family, and we don't want to lose you!

We plan to celebrate First Eucharist in early May with our children and their families. As the date gets closer, we will fill in the details.

We realize that these plans may change due to an uptick in COVID percentages. If our plans change we will notify you via email as soon as possible. If you have any questions, please give me a call directly at 518-785-1605. Please leave me a message if I am not there and I'll get back to you as quickly as I can. Your children are one the greatest gifts that God has shared with me. Thank you!

If you have a **first grader starting our program**, we have enclosed a new child registration form so that we can establish a permanent Faith Formation and sacramental record at OLA.

## Middle and High School Faith Formation (Gr. 6-8)

I am very excited at the thought of having young people back in the building! Middle School Faith Formation will return to Tuesday evenings from 7-8PM in person starting in October. For flexibility, we will again be using St. Mary's Press Discovery Series because it adapts somewhat to learning from home or in-person. We will be adding special evenings in the church, and large group gatherings either as grade levels, or as a large group for experiential learning. Fall semester for 6th grade will be *Exploring the Story of Israel*, 7th grade will be *Exploring the Bible*, 8th grade will be *Seeking Justice*. Youth should have received one of the BreakThrough Bibles we handed out last year, and 6th graders should still have their Bible from 5th grade. We do have some extras on hand should you need one.

If you would like your youth to have a <u>brand new</u> Bible, they can be purchased at <a href="https://www.smp.org/product/4141/Breakthrough/">https://www.smp.org/product/4141/Breakthrough/</a> for \$29.95 +S&H. Hopefully we will grow deeper into all the sacred Scripture holds for us.

**High School Faith Formation** is more involved because it prepares the youth for the Sacrament of Confirmation. We are planning to return to in-person learning on Monday nights from 7-8PM using the Dynamic Catholic series *Decision Point* beginning in 9th grade through 10th grade when we finish with seven special sessions in church with Fr. Burke for immediate preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation in spring of 10th grade. We will also do an in-depth study of the mass, and the Gospels using *From Mass to Mission: Understanding the Mass and its Significance for Our Christian Life* from Liturgy Training Publications.
