
Have a wonderful summer and include OLA events on your calendar.

Elementary Faith Formation (Grades 1-5)

Finding Faith in Life

For the 2024-2025 year, we will continue to use Saint Mary's Press, *Discover: Finding Faith in Life* for grades 1-5. This program uses as it's core text, *The Catholic Children's Bible*. Each child receives their own Bible to keep and use in Grades 2-5. Every fall, a folder with grade appropriate activity booklets for each chapter is given to each child. Our First Graders receive a Children's Bible that is a bit easier to read. They will get *The Catholic Children's Bible* in 2nd grade.

All our families are encouraged to attend the 9 a.m. mass. During this mass we offer Children's Liturgy of the Word, where our youngest children step out of the church and discuss the readings and Gospel. It's a wonderful way to introduce God's

Word to our little ones. Faith Formation sessions will meet on Sunday mornings following the 9 a.m. mass. Our sessions run from **10-11 a.m.** (If the 9 a.m. mass runs a bit over, our end time may also be extended.) The Discover series has a wonderful Family Page on the back of each weekly activity packet. This lets the parents see all the kids have just discussed with our Catechists, and continue the lesson all week. There are Saints and prayers on each packet to share with the whole family. If your child is absent, I will email the home study guide to you so that you can cover that individually.

We are going to shake up our *Family Faith Formation* program this fall. Once a month, October—April, we will host a Family Faith Formation session. We invite our families *(parents and kiddos)* to attend. I ask that you attend a minimum of 3 sessions this year (2024-2025). If you want to come to all of them, I'd be thrilled! Pick those that meet your family's needs, schedules, likes or seem interesting to you. Later this summer I'll have the exact dates and topics out to you. These sessions are an important part of our Faith Formation program and attendance will be kept. We are going to offer these at different times in the hope of better attendance. Our Hospitality Sunday's are going to kept strictly for hospitality. Donuts and coffee, friendship and catching up with one another. We will not hold Family Faith formation at the same time.

We will celebrate First Eucharist in early May with our children and their families. As the date gets closer, we will fill in the details. A separate schedule for First Eucharist Sacramental Prep will be sent out to our families celebrating the sacrament.

Flexibility is of utmost importance as we travel the road in Faith Formation this fall. If our plans change we will notify you via email as soon as possible. If you have any questions, please give me a call directly at 518-785-1605. Please leave me a message if I am not there and I'll get back to you as quickly as I can. Your children are one the greatest gifts that God has shared with me. Thank you!

If you have a **first grader starting our program**, please complete enclosed the new child registration form (reverse side of the registration form) so that we can establish a permanent Faith Formation and sacramental record at OLA.

Faith Formation (Gr. 6-10)

Middle School Faith Formation will return on Monday evenings from 7-8 p.m. We will be adding special evenings for FAMILIES to equip them to build the domestic church in the home. Groups will also have the opportunity to serve at the Regional Food Bank during the year. Fall semester for 6th grade will be Exploring the Story of Israel, 7th grade will be Exploring the Bible, 8th grade will be Seeking Justice. Your young person should have a good readable Bible, and 6th and 7th graders should still have their Bible from 5th grade. We do have some extras on hand should you need one. If you would like your youth to have a <u>brand new</u> Bible, they can be <u>purchased</u> at <u>https://www.smp.org/</u> product/4141/Breakthrough/ for \$32.95+S&H. Hopefully we will grow deeper into all the sacred Scripture holds for us.

High School Faith Formation is more involved because it prepares the youth for the Sacrament of Confirmation. They also meet on **Monday** nights from 7-8 p.m. In spring of 10th grade, we share several special sessions in church with Fr. Burke for immediate preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation which takes place in late April or May at the discretion of the Bishop's schedule. One evening of service at the Regional Food Bank is included.

***In addition to regular Faith Formation, we highly encourage you to see that your teen experiences living their faith by participating in many of the Youth Ministry activities available to them, including retreats, service opportunities within and outside of OLA, and community building events such as lock-ins! Those times "away" from the routine offer the opportunity for young people to connect with each other and with God. That connection is necessary to serve as a foundation for sustaining lifelong faith.

9th /10th grades: Mondays 7-8 p.m.

Look for dates in an upcoming mailing in August. We cannot over-emphasize the importance of regular attendance. Please try your best to set these nights and times aside. Thank you.

Youth Ministry

Here at OLA, Youth Ministry is part of the heart and soul of this community. Teens are valued and revered in every aspect of parish life. Through their active participation, they learn the value of being part of this faith family. They are lectors, Special Ministers of the Eucharist at Mass, Altar Servers, Event Planners, Parish Council Members, and at times the energy that fuels our sails. There is a talented and dedicated group of teens that make up our **Core Team** of youth, supported by a few adult Wisdom Keepers, who create, plan and implement the activities and events the parish enjoys year round. We staff Vacation Bible School with teens, sponsor Monday Nights on the Lot four Mondays in the summer, featuring a barbecue dinner, kickball, bocce, corn hole, and more to enjoy together as a community. We help at the parish picnic, hold pancake breakfasts, feature middle school Roamin' Catholics events, Family Game nights, St. Nicholas' Workshop for the little ones, hold special parish dinners, and the Friendship Luncheon for seniors in February. We offer special occasions to pray together like **Stations of the Cross** in Lent, **Advent prayer**, and a night for high school seniors to pray about their post high school decisions.

But Youth Ministry could not accomplish all of this without the incredibly generous support of the whole parish through our fundraising efforts featuring our three main events, Spring Flower Sale, Fall Mum Sale, and Christmas Wreath Sale. We also continue to benefit from the generosity and efforts of the CLYNK program which financially supports our vision with your donations of 5¢ returnables through the use of the green bags available in the gathering space. OLAYM continues to sponsor a child in Bolivia monthly through *Unbound* towards her education and development. Thank you for helping us continue the mission. We were also able to continue our support of the American Cancer Society through Relay For Life donations...thank you! We share many powerful service **opportunities** in our nearby communities and beyond.
